



## ***Welcome, Spiritual Retreatants!***

Here is a place to retreat, to deeply gather ourselves, to rest.

These facilities are on private land owned by Earth Journey, Inc, and are dedicated by Spiritual Masters to contemplation and retreat.

As such they are **Sacred Spaces**.

They are reserved for retreatants within any Spiritual Path that is dedicated to developing love and compassion.

Retreatants must be self-sufficient and respectful of the land and each other and of the blessing it is to stay here.

*Our spaces:*

- **Small Retreat Cabins:** There are four. Two are 8 by 12' with 5' south-facing porches. A third is a round "earth bag" structure, 12' in diameter. The fourth is 10x12', with a porch, and is generously windowed. They are not electrified, but are equipped simply with beds, dharmic furniture, and battery-powered lamps. They are enclosed and weatherproof. Some sheets and blankets are supplied. They are situated within a short walk of the Bathhouse/Kitchen and the Tibetan Buddhist Stupa. Retreatants bring their own food, prepared/refrigerated in the kitchen. Cost is on a sliding scale, \$20-30 per night, \$500-800 per month. Longer stays may be discussed with the EJ representative.

- **Campsites:** Our Stupa is surrounded by approximately 18 campsites shaded in piñon and juniper woods, situated near the Bathhouse/Kitchen with toilets and showers. Cost is on a sliding scale, \$15-20 per night, \$350-500 per month. Campers bring their own equipment and food, which may be prepared, and stored/refrigerated in the kitchen. Intervals of stay are limited, up to one month. Longer stays may be discussed with an Earth Journey representative.

- **Resident Lama:** Lama Karma Chopal is our resident lama. He is a highly accomplished artist and practitioner within the Karma Kagyu lineage of Tibetan Buddhism, and is available for consultation, if you wish.

**Weekly Group Practices:** At the Stupa during the warm seasons, TBA during cooler seasons. GREEN TARA, Saturdays, 4 pm, Mondays 11 am; and CHENREZIG, Fridays, 2pm.

**Important to Note:** These are retreat spaces honoring the Straight Path to our spiritual core. Practice here is to be honest and bare:

NO intoxicants: drugs, "plant medicines", alcohol, or smoking.

WiFi access ranges from spotty to non-existent.
